


Green ON Solar Rebates

NOTICE OF MATERIAL CHANGE

Earlier this year, it came to the attention of the Ottawa Renewable Energy Co-operative's staff and Board of Directors that the modelling for some of the projects in the Co-operative's portfolio underestimated the impact that snow coverage would have on existing project generation, due to limited region-specific research prior to the construction of these projects. This new information has been taken into account for all projects under construction. The Ottawa Renewable Energy Co-operative included a contingency line in its 2017-18 budget to account for unknown situations and this will not bear a significant impact on returns to investors. Financial models moving forward will be adjusted to account for this new information.

The Co-operative has added an amendment to its current offering statement, fully outlining the impact of this discovery, as well the actions taken by the Board of Directors to address these impacts.
