

Pre-Construction FIT Contracts Cancelled

How Will OREC be Affected?



On Friday, July 13th the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) issued the notice that over 750 contracts for FIT and Large Renewable Projects (LRP) had been "identified for wind-down". Among these projects were four contracts secured by the Ottawa Renewable Energy Co-operative which were all in the pre-construction phase.

The Co-operative does not believe that this will affect members, investors or the organization significantly. The Co-op's Board of Directors and staff were anticipating this announcement, and have plans in place for how to proceed.
